



CAMP OLIVER PARENT/GUARDIAN INFORMATION

Parents/Guardians MUST check in at the Check-In area and with Health Supervisor BEFORE leaving the premises.

Please make sure your camper has had lunch prior to arrival.

Please bring your child to camp at 2:00pm on the Sunday your camp session begins.

Pick up time is 2PM on Friday, your child will only be release to the person/s you have stated on the Policy Agreement and Consent form, ID will be checked – Please Do Not Be Late.

The following must be in our office **2 WEEKS** prior to your camper's arrival:

1. Medical Health History Forms
2. Policy Agreement and Consent Form (both sides)
3. Camp fee



DIRECTIONS TO CAMP OLIVER:

From San Diego area, Take I-8 East. Exit at Highway 79, towards Julian. Turn left off the exit. Go 1 mile to Riverside Drive and turn left. We are the 3rd driveway on the right.

IN CASE OF A MEDICAL EMERGENCY: You will be notified immediately at the number you listed on the enrollment form. Please be sure to list your child's medical insurance information and sign the "consent to treatment" on the Health History form.

UPON ARRIVAL AT CAMP: Your camper will be checked by the Health Supervisor for head lice and general health. If these requirements are not met, you will be notified. For the health, safety and well being of your own child and others in camp **PLEASE SEND A HEALTHY CHILD TO CAMP. IF YOUR CHILD IS FOUND TO HAVE HEAD LICE OUR OFFICE WILL CONTACT YOU TO PICK YOUR CHILD UP IMMEDIATELY. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR CHILD DOES NOT HAVE HEAD LICE BEFORE SENDING THEM TO CAMP.**

We have a "no cell phone" policy at Camp Oliver. Please see our Supply List for other items not allowed at camp. Not only are cell phones expensive and may get lost, stolen or damaged, we are promoting an environment where your child can practice their independence. We will contact you in the unlikely event that your camper has a problem while at Camp Oliver.

For safety reasons digital cameras are not allowed at Camp Oliver. Children may bring a disposable camera.
